Privacy Policy

I collect personally-identifiable information when you enquire about my services.

When you make an online or telephone enquiry, I ask for your contact information (full name, email address, contact phone number, and address).

When you engage my services, I will also ask you for additional details: including personal information about you, and your friends and family in relation to the person who has died.

What do I do with your data?

I use the information collected to liaise with you and to help organise the funeral you have asked me to conduct.

Whilst I am working on the ceremony, this data is stored on a password protected computer and in a locked filing cabinet.

After the funeral I will delete all emails and computer files and destroy all papers relating to the funeral except a single copy of the final script. I will retain your contact details unless you ask me not to.

I do not collect any payment transaction details. I do not request or knowingly collect personally-identifiable personal information from anyone under the age of 16yrs.

Who do I share your information with?

I may share some details with other professionals immediately involved with the funeral, for instance the funeral director, in order to optimise the service with which you are provided . I do not share any of your information with any other third party. I will not sell your data and I promise to keep your data safe and secure.

At the foot of all Thresholding emails is the message "If you do not want to receive emails from me in the future, please send me an email with **UNSUBSCRIBE** in the subject and your details will be removed from my records."
